Results

a) Knowledge;

Student:

- has a knowledge and understands legal terms in the scope of American bankruptcy law, K_W03; - understands the basic features and functions of bankruptcy law, as well as the rules of functioning in the common-law system; has a knowledge of the position of a creditor, a debtor and other bankruptcy law officials, K_W06.

b) Skills;

Student:

- has an ability of applying of the theoretical knowledge to the analysis and interpretation of legal and economic phenomenas, K_U02.

Methods

The class has a form of lecture and case studies.

Finals: Exam in the form of one-choice test, 50% of correct answers required.

Topics:The course presents fundamentals rules of American Bankruptcy Law. It introduces students to the meaning and sources of bankruptcy law, forms of bankruptcy proceedings, role of bankruptcy courts and trustees, basic terms: property of estates, preferences, proof of claim, liens in bankruptcy, exemption, liquidation, reorganization, bankruptcies of municipalities.
